ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

GED: General Education Development

The GED program offered to those who lack either a High School diploma, or a GED certificate. Residents receive instruction in abstract writing, reading skills, science, social studies, and math. A passing score of 450 is required to achieve the GED certificate.

ABE: Adult Basic Education II/III

Offered to those who lack a GED certificate. Residents receive instruction in abstract writing, reading skills, science, social studies, and math. A passing Score in the TABE must be achieved to receive Milestones and promote to the GED class when available.

ABE I/ESL: English as a Second Language

Non-or Limited English Speaking residents will learn to read, write, and speak English. Certificates of completion shall be awarded upon successfully completing the ESL course. A passing score in the TABE must be achieved to receive Milestones and promote to the ABE II/III class when available.
