

SPECIFICATIONS - CLASS C (JUMPSUIT) UNIFORM
(MALE/FEMALE)

A one-piece coverall with a collar and elastic waistband.

Color

Olive green.

Material: Shall be 65% Polyester, 35% cotton twill or facsimile, 5.5 oz for summer and 7.5 oz for winter. Black, nonrusting metal snaps, with all zippers to be noncorrosive brass.

Two horizontal, plain-front breast pockets with zippered closures and a pencil pocket on the left front breast pocket. Breast pocket zippers to be concealed by a fabric flap.

Two front pockets with snapped passed-through openings.

Two hip pockets with zippered closures.

Lower leg pockets optional.

The Class C uniform will have the cloth badge, as described in Section 2707.

The Class C uniform will have a sewn-on cloth nameplate, as described in Section 2715, which will be sewn centered above the right breast pocket.

The Class C uniform will have the standard California Youth Authority (CYA) shoulder patches.

The departmental seven-point badge facsimile will be sewn centered 1" above the left-breast pocket (3" point-to-point).

SUPERINTENDENT - OPTIONAL UNIFORM

Due to the extreme differences in the weather conditions of institutional/facilities' locations throughout the State, individual Superintendents may prescribe other optional uniforms based on those weather conditions (i.e., heavy coats in extreme cold or snow conditions, heavy boots in rough terrain areas). If done, such optional uniforms shall be authorized by the individual Superintendent, in writing, with copies of such authorization to be submitted to the Deputy Director, Institutions and Camps Branch, prior to such authorization being in effect.

FUNERAL UNIFORM 2650

The official departmental uniform authorized for wearing at the funeral of another correctional Peace Officer, or any other law enforcement official when attending in an official capacity, shall be the full Class A uniform. In all cases, this shall include the draped departmental badge.

REGULATION BADGES, FUNERAL/MOURNING PERIOD 2655

The departmental regulation dome badge shall be draped in the approved manner at all correctional institutions immediately upon the determination that a correctional Peace Officer has been killed in the line of duty. Such draping shall continue through the day of the funeral, or as deemed appropriate by the Director of the Youth Authority.

No draping of the departmental regulation badge shall occur for other than correctional Peace Officers killed in the line of duty, except as authorized by the Superintendent.

The draping of the badge shall be in accordance with the guidelines below:

A 3/4" wide band of black elastic shall be placed horizontally across the middle portion of the badge. The drape is not to cover the badge number. This is the tradition of Peace Officers showing their unity after the tragic loss of a fellow Peace Officer.
