**Change of Meeting Location and Meeting Times**

**Notice of Preparation and Public Scoping Meeting Announcement**  
**Level II Infill Correctional Facilities Project**

The California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) will be holding a public scoping meeting on the Notice of Preparation (NOP) for the construction of proposed level II infill correctional facilities at the California Institution for Men on January 30, 2013. The NOP is the first step in the preparation of an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) that will address the potential placement of level II infill correctional facilities at CIM as well as four other sites on existing CDCR prisons.

The revised meeting place and schedule of the NOP workshop/hearings in Chino is as follows:

- ▲ On January 30, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. at the Chaffey College Chino Community Center, 5890 College Park Avenue, Chino, CA 91710 **(Please note that the second meeting to be conducted in the Chino area has been postponed from its previously advertised 5:00 p.m. start time to 6:00 p.m.)**

Senate Bill 1022 (2012) directs CDCR to consider the construction of up to three infill correctional facilities with a total capacity of 2,376 beds. This legislation directs CDCR to consider the use of five potential development sites for the infill facilities that are situated on the grounds of seven existing state prisons including: California Institution for Men (CIM) in Chino, CA; California State Prison, Sacramento (SAC)/Folsom State Prison (FSP) in Folsom, CA; California State Prison, Solano (SOL)/California Medical Facility (CMF) in Vacaville, CA; Mule Creek State Prison (MCSP) in Lone, CA; and, R. J. Donovan Correctional Facility (RJD) in south San Diego County, CA.

Of the five infill development sites CDCR has proposed to construct a 792-bed level II correctional facility at RJD and a 1,584-bed level II correctional facility at MCSP. However, the EIR for these facilities will also address the potential use of infill sites on the grounds of CIM, CMF/SOL, and FSP/SAC; these sites will be evaluated as alternatives to the two proposed sites in San Diego and Lone. SB 1022 also mandates the closure of CRC (a level II correctional facility) no later than December 31, 2016 or within 6 months after construction of the three level II dormitory facilities, whichever is earlier. Upon closure, the existing inmates at this facility would be transferred to other CDCR prisons.
