Internet Protocol Television Integration (IPTVI)

IPTVI is a multi-channel streaming network that delivers secure educational and rehabilitative television programming to inmates.

Programming consists of six channels, streaming a variety of up-to-date material. This material delivers rehabilitative and educational content, designed to supplement the offenders' core curriculum and academic literacy, allowing them the opportunity to achieve milestone credits.

DRP provides IPTVI programming 24 hours a day, every day. Round-the-clock access proves beneficial for those unable to attend classes due to conflicts in their schedules.

CDCR's Division of Rehabilitative Programs (DRP) manages adult inmate and parolee rehabilitative programs. Its top priority is to provide rehabilitative programming and life skills to offenders in an effort to reduce their likelihood of reoffending after their release from prison. DRP is comprised of the Office of Offender Services (OS), the Office of Correctional Education (OCE), and the Office of Program Accountability and Support (OPAS).
