In-Prison Sex Offender Management (SOM) Program

SOM is a pilot program which addresses the risks and needs of offenders who are required to register pursuant to Penal Code Section 290. This program provides evidence-based treatment for offenders in community programs prior to their release.

Location(s): Substance Abuse Treatment Facility (SATF)

Length of Program: 8 Months

Enrollment: Enrollment is for offenders who are required to register pursuant to Penal Code Section 290.

Eligibility Requirements: Eligibility requires a static 99R score of 4 or higher to be considered for placement in this program.

CDCR's Division of Rehabilitative Programs (DRP) manages adult inmate and parolee rehabilitative programs. Its top priority is to provide rehabilitative programming and life skills to offenders in an effort to reduce their likelihood of reoffending after their release from prison. DRP is comprised of the Office of Offender Services (OS), the Office of Correctional Education (OCE), and the Office of Program Accountability and Support (OPAS).
