Day Reporting Centers (DRC)

Day Reporting Centers offer a “one-stop shop” comprehensive service delivery program designed to address the assessed needs of parolee participants. DRCs are non-residential programs with limited transitional housing available. *Services provided include:*

- Individual and Group Counseling
- Batterer’s Violence Program
- Anger Management
- Parenting and Family Reintegration
- Cognitive and Life Skills Training
- Education/GED Preparation
- Budgeting and Money Management
- Employment Services
- Substance Use Disorder Education
- Criminal Thinking

Location(s): DRCs are administered throughout California by CDCR in partnership with public entities and private providers. *Programs are currently available in the following counties:*

- Alameda
- San Francisco
- Santa Barbara
- Fresno
- Kern
- San Joaquin
- Monterey
- Santa Clara
- Los Angeles
- Imperial
- Orange
- San Bernardino
- Riverside
- San Diego.

Some public entity agreements allow for county probationers and CDCR parolees to program at the same site.

Length of Program: Up to 180 days. May extend up to one year on a case-by-case basis.

Enrollment: Referral by parolee’s Agent of Record (AOR) via CDCR form 1502, Activity Report.

Eligibility Requirements: All parolees subject to the jurisdiction of Division of Adult Parole Operations (DAPO) are eligible to participate. Parolees should have an identified Correctional Offender Management Profiling for Alternative Sanctions (COMPAS) need.

CDCR's Division of Rehabilitative Programs (DRP) manages adult inmate and parolee rehabilitative programs. Its top priority is to provide rehabilitative programming and life skills to offenders in an effort to reduce their likelihood of reoffending after their release from prison. DRP is comprised of the Office of Offender Services (OS), the Office of Correctional Education (OCE), and the Office of Program Accountability and Support (OPAS).
