3 Ways of Sending Money

Lock Box:

- ❖ No fee for sending money via money order, personal check, or cashier's check
- ❖ Completely fill out the Money Order Deposit Form (coupon) with sender name and address
- ❖ Make check or money order payable to JPay
- ❖ Mail to: JPay, 2202 South Figueroa St, Box #3001, Los Angeles, CA 90007
- ❖ Do not include any letters or notes with payment, because these will be discarded
- ❖ Personal checks will be held for 10 days
- ❖ Maximum of \$999.99 per Money Order Deposit Form (coupon)
- ❖ Email not required
- ❖ Inmate funds only; JPay does not accept Family Visit, TCL, Restitution only, etc.

EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer):

- ❖ Paid service with a fee
- ❖ Funds posted to inmate's account within 1 to 3 days
- ❖ Family can either select inmate trust account or restitution only

- ❖ Sender name and address required on check or money order
- ❖ Make check or money order payable to CDCR
- ❖ Include Inmate Name and Inmate CDCR # on check
