



DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY VERIFICATION (FORM I-9) GUIDELINES

It is your responsibility to provide proof of employment eligibility by completing the Department of Homeland Security's Employment Eligibility Verification Form I-9 prior to the deadline listed in Step 3 of your Confirmation Notice.

Complete Section 1, "Employee Information and Attestation" on page 1, sign it, and date it. Do not attempt to complete any other section.

Make a copy of the identification listed on page 4 of the I-9 document. The "Instructions" button at the top of the document provides special clarification of any technicalities that may arise regarding which documents are acceptable.

After making a copy for your records, send page 1 of the completed Form I-9 **AND THE IDENTIFICATION LISTED ON PAGE 4 OF FORM I-9** to our office as described in your Confirmation Notice. Do not forget to sign and date Page 1.

IF YOU FAIL TO PROVIDE THE COMPLETED FORM I-9 AND COPIES OF REQUIRED IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS, YOUR APPOINTMENT WILL BE RESCINDED. In addition to sending a copy, you will be required to bring the original documents to the academy check-in. You may be turned away from the academy and denied employment if you fail to bring the documents with you to the check-in.
