DEFINITIONS

Average Daily Population (ADP): The average population for a stated population for a specified time period.

Opened Dates: The opening date by month/year for a housing level, reception center, secure housing unit, in-state contract beds, correctional treatment center, camp, other unit type or California Out-of-State Correctional Facility.

NOTES:

1. The quarterly ADP is calculated using the total of three monthly ADPs during each quarter divided by three. The yearly ADP is calculated using the total of four quarterly ADP calculations divided by four.
2. California Out-of-State Correctional Facilities began in October 2006 with the voluntary housing of non-serious, non-violent offenders in other state institutions. This program is used in order to reduce the inmate population being housed in California Institutions.
